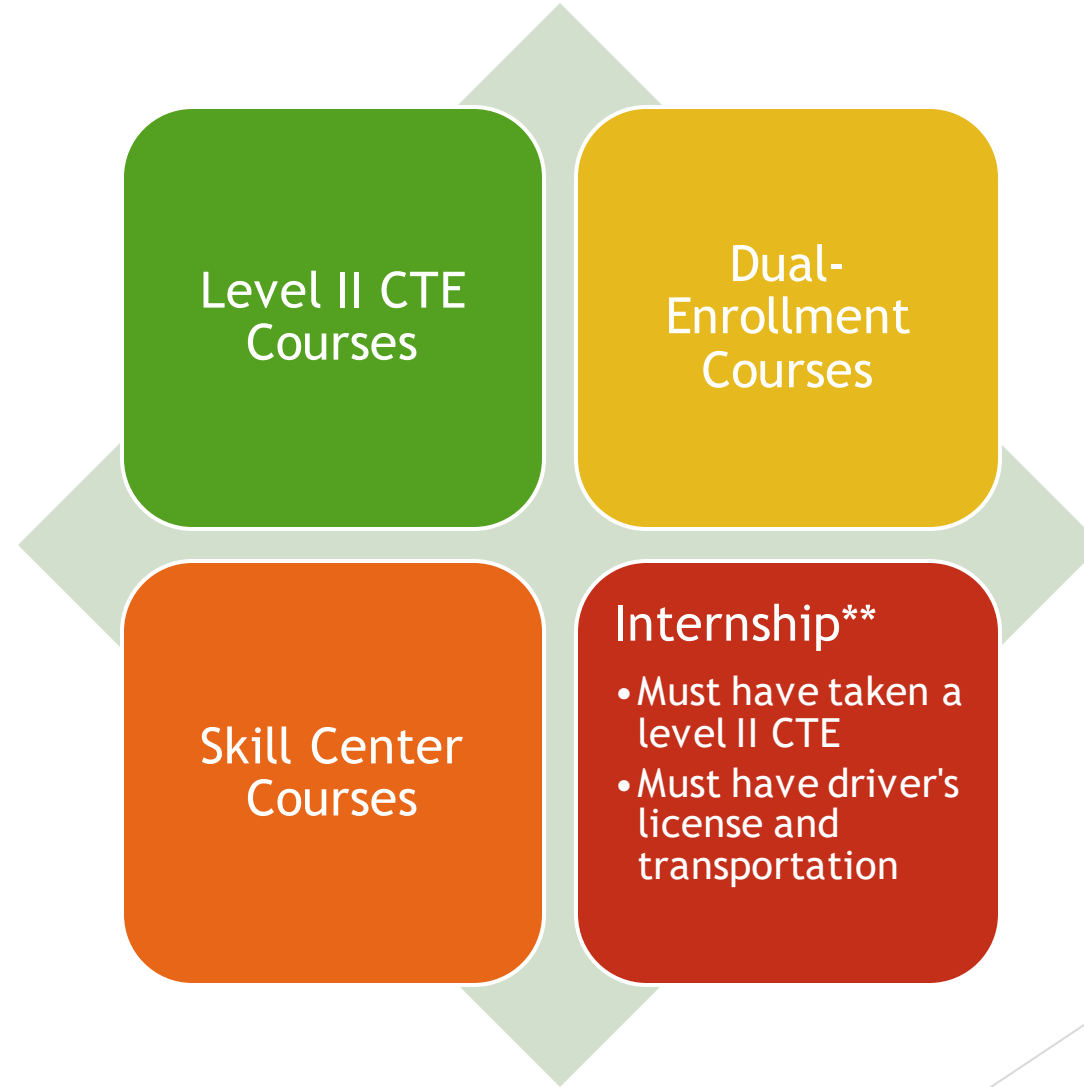

Dual-Enrollment

► Requirements

- 2.8 unweighted GPA (ACT or Placement test)
- School approval

► Onslow County Schools will cover tuition, books and other fees are not included in tuition.

► College courses are not monitored by the high school.

► Dropping a course

- If dropping a course results in less than minimum required courses, you will be rescheduled if dropped prior to the end of the 1st grading period.
 - Otherwise, you will lose a credit for the semester or receive the grade given

If you are graduating, you are exiting the Public School system.

SAT Scholarship

All students who meet requirements are guaranteed the scholarship

Requirements

- 3.5 Weighted GPA (B+ Average)
- 23+ Composite ACT Score
- Fulfilled Graduation Requirements
 - Math 4
- Community Service (20 Hours must be completed senior year)
 - 100 Hours = \$1500
 - 75 Hours = \$750
 - May include 30 school or church-based hours
- All hours due by Jan. 31st of senior year
