Internship

- ❖ Requirements
 - Must have license and transportation
 - Must complete an information packet (available March 5th)
- ❖ Students should try to find a location for the placement
 - Mrs. Huie can provide support if unable to find a location

WorkKeys

- ❖ All students who have taken a Level II CTE course
- ❖ Nationally recognized career readiness exam
- ❖ Can be added to your resume
- ❖ Can be used to advocate for higher pay/position

❖ Requirements

- Must have consistent, reliable transportation
- Must have space in schedule

❖ Rules

- Students may NOT be on campus outside of scheduled periods. If you need to be:
 - you will need to sign in as a guest at the front office after last class;
 - Must have permission from a staff member and be with that staff member;
 - The staff member should have planning during that time

Early Graduation

January 2025

- ❖ Dual-enrollment
 - Eligible for Spring semester; not summer
- ❖ May participate in senior Spring events
 - May have different procedures
 - Must sign in at the front office for on-campus events
- ❖ Sports
 - Ineligible after graduation
 - No Spring sports; Winter sports until the end of 1st semester
- ❖ Graduation = Loss of access to school sponsored services and programs
- ❖ You may have an all off campus schedule for the Spring and stay enrolled
- ❖ Requirements
 - Parent/guardian permission
 - School permission
 - Clear post-graduation plan
- ❖ Diploma awarded in June
 - We can write a letter as proof of completion

ACT Scores

SENDING SCORES

- ❖ You can add colleges to MyACT portal to send scores for free
 - From the time you set up your account until 2 days after taking the exam
- ❖ Outside of this window you will need to pay the fee from ACT to send official scores.
- ❖ Superscore
 - Highest cumulative score from all testing sessions
- ❖ Composite 23+ = Free Parking Pass

 - Contact ACT directly
- ❖ Please write your information down in a secure location.

All students who meet requirements are guaranteed the scholarship

Requirements

- 3.5 Weighted GPA (B+ Average)
- 23+ Composite ACT Score
- Fulfilled Graduation Requirements
 - Math 4
- Community Service (20 Hours must be completed senior year)
 - 100 Hours = \$1500
 - 75 Hours = \$750
 - May include 30 school or church-based hours
- All hours due by Jan. 31st of senior year
