

Swansboro High School Senior Reserved Painted Parking Spaces

WHO: Seniors Only

WHY: To build school spirit
To create a senior tradition
To support senior events

HOW MUCH: \$25 – this will be in addition to the cost of the parking permit (\$25)

THE PROCESS:

- **Step 1:** Purchase a SBHS parking permit from the front office for \$25.00 on Monday, August 7th from 10:00am-2:00pm. Remember, all fees from prior years must be paid for before a parking permit can be purchased.
- **Step 2:** What you need turned in by August 14th:
 - A non-refundable payment of \$25.00 (checks made payable to Swansboro HS Project Graduation) for the painted parking fee.
 - A completed application for the permit (see attached).
 - A signed copy of the Reserved Painted Parking Space Contract (attached).
 - A copy of the design for your parking spot **MUST** be attached or drawn on the back of the contract and must be approved prior to painting. We will keep this, so make a copy for yourself.

Designs must be completed on the Senior Parking Design Request form and returned to the front office for approval by the administration. Your design should be clearly drawn on this form and must include the colors you will be using on your parking space. Once your design has been reviewed, you will receive a confirmation of approval or a request to make changes. The design may not exceed the parking space outline, and it must be school appropriate and follow the below guidelines.

Guidelines for your Design: Think of your space as a t-shirt you would wear to school. Your parking spot must meet dress code approval. Keep it classy! Any designs associated with gangs, advertising drugs, alcohol, violence, obscene or offensive slogans or symbols, handicap symbols or symbols that cause confusion or promote inappropriate behavior will not be allowed or approved. You may include your name, jersey number, instrument you play, hobby, famous quotes or slogans and anything unique to you so as it meets administrative approval.

Prohibited:

- **No offensive language, pictures, or symbols.**
- **No negative or rude language (Be nice).**
- **No “gang-style tagging.”**
- **No double entendre’s (Double meanings).**
- **You may use YOUR NAME.** If you want to use a nickname it must be approved. (A boyfriend’s or girlfriend’s name is **NOT** allowed.)

- **Prohibited items** will be painted over at the discretion of administration. Disciplinary action may be taken & you may forfeit your right to a parking space and /or to park on campus. If applicable, no refunds will occur for the parking permit or painted parking.

Mandatory Paint Options (paint can only be water based exterior latex; no spray, reflective or fluorescent permitted):

- You will provide your own paint. (Consider sharing with others.)

PAINTING: August 14-27, 2023 (painting must be complete before August 28, 2023)

- **Step 1:** Check with the front office to be sure your design has been approved by administration. Paintings that have not been approved in advance could result in your spot being painted over.

What you need:

- Approved paint
- A copy of your approved design – so you will have your approved template to follow. **You must follow this design exactly – no changes allowed.**

- **Step 2:** Begin painting.

What you need:

- your copy of your approved design
- a broom to sweep off your spot before painting. (This will save you lots of time.)
- paint brushes, paint, or painter's tape and any other supplies you may need

PRIOR to last day of school:

Students are required to paint over the design in black water-based exterior latex paint no later than June 7, 2024 or a \$50 fine will be assessed prior to graduation. Remember, all fees must be paid prior to participating in graduation activities.

I hereby agree to abide by all of the following rules and regulations corresponding to my privilege of having a reserved painted parking spot:

- Upon purchasing my parking spot I will only use water-based exterior latex paint.
- I know I am not allowed spray paint, reflective paint, or fluorescent paint of any kind.
- I will only paint within the marked parking space that is drawn for me.
- I know I have to bring my own brushes and painting supplies to decorate my spot.
- I will never park in another parking space that is assigned to someone else or let anyone park in my space.
- I will only paint my approved design following all the guidelines in my parking space.
- I understand that my painted design must be completed by August 27, 2023.
- **If I do not abide by any of these rules, I realize my parking spot will be taken away and will be painted over, and I will not receive a refund.**
- If I park in someone else's painted parking spot, I will receive disciplinary action.
- I agree to paint over my design in black water-based exterior latex paint at the end of the school year. If neither are completed by June 7, 2024 I will incur a \$50 fine that must be paid for prior to graduation activities.

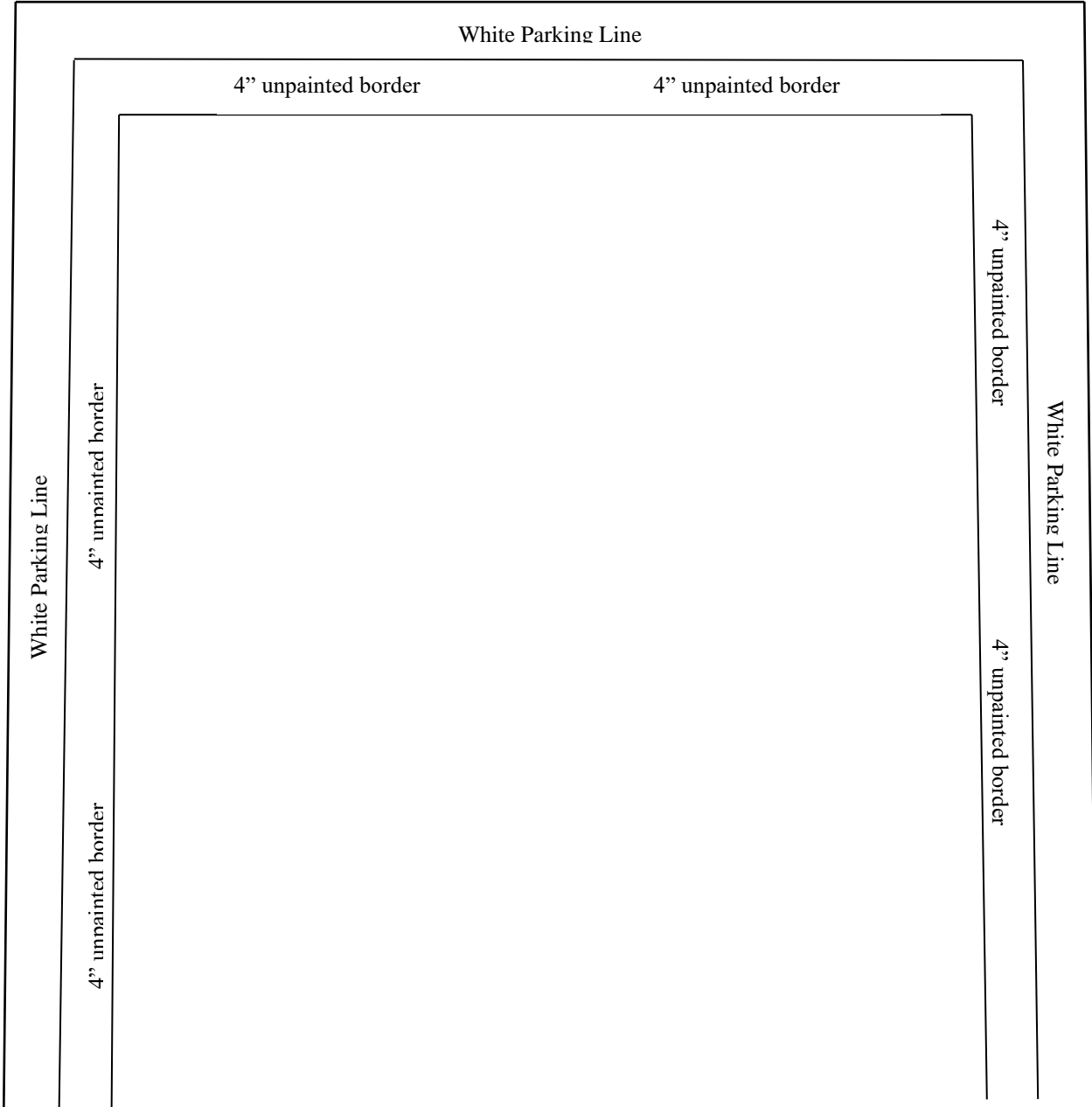
