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The goal of Curriculum Assistance (Support for Interventions) is to support and reteach skills necessary to improve success in content area classes (English, Science, Mathematics, History, and other electives). *This class should NOT be regarded as a "study hall" or "free period"*. Students will receive help to understand and complete assignments given in the general education classroom. Students will also receive direct instruction in the goals on their Individualized Education Plan (IEP)

<u>Grading Policy:</u> This course is worth **one credit** toward meeting graduation requirements.

10% Organization (DAILY - Binder/Notebooks/Agenda/and Folders)

Point breakdown: (Student will earn up to 3 points each day)

1 point-Participation in Curriculum support lessons and activities (includes daily warm-ups)

1 point- Actively working on assignments or study for general education classes

1point- Displaying appropriate social skills (includes "time on task" behavior)

25% Quizzes

There will a quiz EVERY Friday

35% Scott's Classwork

Students may be assigned assignments that focus on math, reading, and or writing skills related to the student's IEP goals. These additional assignments will be graded.

30% Homework Completion (for Core courses):

Completing assignments from core classes, this grade may an average of your other 3 classes.

Student Responsibilities

- Bring materials to class
- Personal needs (restroom/ water) BEFORE class
- ❖ Active participation in <u>all</u> teacher-directed and independent activities is required.
- ❖ Participate!! THIS IS NOT STUDY HALL / FREE TIME
- Keep working for 80 minutes.
- ❖ Be respectful.
- Let Ms. Scott know about due dates for other classes.
- Follow classroom rules (posted).

Cell Phone and Electronic Device Usage Policy:

Cell phones and other electronic devices should be kept out of sight unless given permission by Ms. Scott.

First offense: phone taken for the rest of the period by Ms. Scott.

Second offense: Phone confiscated for the day.

Third Offense: Phone turned into office, parent must pick up.

Multiple Offenses: Loss of electronic device privileges for the semester.

**** **Refusal** to turn over the cell phone will be treated as insubordinate behavior and will result in **immediate** disciplinary action. **See JHS handbook for more information.**

Rewards:

The best reward will come from your academic success! This means earning credits to graduate on time!

Consequences for behavior:

Violations will follow the Levels of Discipline as outlined in Student Handbook

1st Offense: Verbal Warning

2nd Offense: Teacher Conference, Parent Contact

3rd Offense: Teacher/Lunch Detention, Parent Conference

4th Offense: Disciplinary referral to administration

Note: Any behavior which is detrimental to the learning atmosphere or to the safety of the teacher or students warrants immediate disciplinary action.

Classroom Procedures:.

- **Sharpen all pencils before the daily lesson begins**. If you know you do not have a pencil, please get one before the start of the daily lesson.
- Begin "Bell Ringers" immediately after entering the classroom.
- After each daily lesson, students are responsible for being actively involved with homework, assignments or study from their content classes.
- Return any classroom materials to their proper locations.
- Remain in your seat until you are dismissed by the teacher NOT the bell.
